1. District ALICE and TECIP Committee Update

On Tuesday, October 17, the district held the annually required ALICE trainings in all three buildings. Mr. Seevers publicly thanked the Jamestown Mayor, Police Chief, Lieutenant, Fire Chiefs from Silvercreek Township and New Jasper Township for their involvement from the first responders. Each building had specific drills that are grade level appropriate for the ALICE training. ALICE stands for— Alert Lockdown Inform Counter Evacuate.

Mr. Seevers then discussed the need to have a plan for what should happen after a crisis. TECIP stands for Traumatic Event Crisis Intervention Plans.
